**Reporting of Concerns Regarding Accounting and Other Matters**

We have adopted procedures for reporting concerns regarding accounting, internal accounting controls, auditing and other legal and regulatory matters. These procedures are designed to provide a channel of communication for employees and other interested persons who have concerns about the conduct of Invitation Homes Inc. or any of its people.

Any person may report to Invitation Homes Inc. any accounting allegation, legal allegation or retaliatory act. Reports can be made openly, confidentially or anonymously (i) by contacting the Audit Committee in writing at Invitation Homes Inc., Attn: Audit Committee, 1717 Main Street, Suite 2000, Dallas, Texas 75201; (ii) by contacting the Chief Legal Officer in writing or in person at Invitation Homes Inc., Attn: Chief Legal Officer, 1717 Main Street, Suite 2000, Dallas, Texas 75201; (iii) by contacting the Vice President – Internal Audit in writing or in person at Invitation Homes Inc., Attn: Vice President – Internal Audit, 1717 Main Street, Suite 2000, Dallas, Texas 75201; (iv) by submitting a report online at [www.reportlineweb.com/invitationhomes](http://www.reportlineweb.com/invitationhomes) or (v) by calling the toll free ethics hotline at 877-231-3984 at any time.

To the extent possible, reports should be factual rather than speculative or conclusory and should contain as much specific information as possible to allow for proper assessment. In addition, reports should contain sufficient corroborating information to support the commencement of an investigation.

Invitation Homes Inc. strictly prohibits any retaliation for reporting a possible violation of law, ethics or company policy, no matter whom the report concerns.
